## AAP Conference Summer 2025: July 25-28 The Garrison Institute

The AAP 2025 Conference.... Will be at the Garrison Institute in New York. Garrison is a beautiful, large, sprawling ex-monastery, set in quiet, meditative grounds, 50 miles upstream from the Big Apple, on the banks of the Hudson River.

Here are just a couple of takeaways:

Tom and Anne Yeomans emphasized how psychosynthesis provides something at the level of what is necessary to save humanity. Gillian added further that we must not only live from our souls, as pointed out, but that it is our soul that lives *through* our personalities here on this planet. At this point, when the world is in the state it is in, the ability of psychosynthesis to provide context, meaning, and purpose stands out even more.

As we focus on paths forward, the need to ground ourselves becomes evident. Everyone seemed to converge on a need to provide some level of ‘basics of psychosynthesis’, which when we can come back to the basics it will be a very grounding action. The educational component in the work of advancing psychosynthesis is related to this set of ‘basics’, but it was pointed out how Assagioli believed in sharing information in an open way – some would therefore stringently approach this in a pro bono manner. In moving forward, the balance needs to be struck as we explore ways to develop both psychosynthesis and education.

The larger sphere of psychosynthesis must include a radical departure from traditional norms in the community. This means not only including other communities and sharing psychosynthesis but also transforming our understanding of psychosynthesis and the unfolding process of it by learning from these other communities. Only then can the true potential of this outstanding framework, aimed at synthesis in our lives, be reached.

To mark the 50<sup>th</sup> anniversary year of Roberto Assagioli’s death, AAP has launched what we believe to be the first-ever Psychosynthesis Creativity contest. The theme of this inaugural contest is “**Connection**”.
